Baseline Emissions & Commitment

Our Scope 1 and Scope 2 emissions for the 2025 baseline year totalled 0.86 tCO₂e across 100 weddings delivered.

Scope 1 – Travel emissions: 0.50 tCO₂e

Scope 2 – Electricity (solar-supported home office): 0.36 tCO₂e

Scope 3 – Proportionate supply chain emissions: minimal relative to venue operations.

We commit to reducing our total emissions by a minimum of 15 percent by 2030 through operational efficiency, increased electric vehicle usage and ongoing energy reduction measures.

Our strategy prioritises reduction before offsetting.

Actions Delivered (2023–2025)

- Calculated baseline emissions and implemented formal Sustainability Policy.
- Installed solar panels at home office reducing grid electricity reliance.
- Transitioned fully to digital booking, contracts and invoicing.
- Implemented route optimisation and local DJ allocation system.
- Introduced equipment lifecycle management to reduce replacement frequency.
- Maintained exclusive use of LED lighting systems.
- Increased sustainability communication with venues and couples.

12–18 Month Reduction Measures

- Increase proportion of electric and hybrid vehicle usage within DJ team.
- Further reduce average travel miles per wedding through smarter allocation.
- Install smart energy monitoring plugs across office and equipment charging points.
- Explore verified UK-based carbon offset schemes for residual emissions.
- Conduct interim emissions recalculation in 2027.

Before 2030

- Achieve minimum 15 percent reduction in total emissions from 2025 baseline.
- Increase electric vehicle representation to at least 50 percent of team fleet where feasible.
- Maintain zero paper operations.
- Continue annual emissions reporting and public transparency.
- Align with venue partners who demonstrate strong sustainability credentials.
